



The Udall City Council met for the City Council Meeting on Wednesday July 9th, 2025, at 6:30pm in the Udall City Hall Council Room. Matt McAllister, Mayor, called the meeting to order. Council members present were Dan Rutschman, Randy Hoffman, Jim Caywood, Craig Hopkins, and David Franz. Quorum established. Also, present were Jennifer Mays, Erik King, Tim Brooks, Leonard Mumford, Dave Williams, Payge Cooper, Pastor Jack Wellman, Brandon Foster, Jennifer Bonnell

Meeting brought to order by McAllister at 6:30pm

Pledge of Allegiance Invocation – Pastor Jack Wellman

Modification to Agenda – None

MOTION by Hoffman to accept the agenda as presented, SECONDED by Hopkins. McAllister called for a vote. All Ayes. MOTION Carried.

Business from the floor – Jennifer Bonnell – Update on the new property and culvert, discussion and KDOT's rules. They need to put gravel in the ditches instead of the culvert. The Clerk gave her the permits.


