NEW RATES FOR THE CITY OF UDALL

The City of Udall is announcing adjustments to several service fees, most notably impacting trash collection. Effective immediately, residential trash service will increase by \$4.00, while senior citizens will see a \$2.00 increase. Commercial trash collection fees are also rising by \$10.00. In addition, the city is implementing new rates for recycling services, with residential recycling increasing and now - \$8.38 and commercial recycling now- \$22.52. Beyond these specific increases, a standard 2% increase is being applied to all city fees. As an example, a contractor's license, previously \$25.00, will now cost \$25.50, and pet tags are rising from \$5.00 to \$5.10. The City of Udall appreciates your understanding as these adjustments are made.




