

ORDINANCE NO. 698

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13, SECTION 13-212 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF UDALL REGARDING DISCHARGING WATER ON DITCHES OR ALLEYS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF UDALL, KANSAS, THAT:

SECTION ONE. Section 13-212 of the Code of the City of Udall is hereby amended to read as follows:

13-212. Discharging chemicals on ditches or alleys.


It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to throw or discharge chemicals into any ditch, street, avenue, or alley in the city or to cause any chemicals to stand or form pools or to flow in a stream thereon. The drainage of rainwater or grass/plant watering shall be exempt. This section shall not apply to persons cleaning or flushing such streets, avenues, or alleys under the authority of the governing body, nor of the fire department.

SECTION TWO. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption and publication once in the official city newspaper by the following summary:


Ordinance No. 698 Summary

On April 10, 2024, the Governing Body passed Ordinance No. 698. The ordinance amends Chapter 13, Section 13-212 of the Code of the City of Udall, Kansas, regarding discharging chemicals on ditches or alleys. The ordinance shall be in full force and effect after the publication of this summary once in the official city newspaper.
